William Glenn Osborne was appointed Director of Music for the Cathedral and Archdiocesan Liturgies at the Cathedral of Mary Our Queen in Baltimore in January. He previously served as Director of Music at Holy Redeemer Catholic Church in Kissimmee, Florida, and Past-Dean of the Central Florida Chapter of the American Guild of Organists.



Prior to this, Mr. Osborne served as the Director of Liturgical Music for the Roman Catholic Diocese of Orlando, Florida. and as Director of Music and Organist at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Albany, NY. He studied organ, improvisation, and composition in France, living in Aix-en-Provence and Lyon. Before studying abroad, he earned degrees from Westminster Choir College and the University of Notre Dame where he studied organ with William Hays and Craig Cramer, respectively. Mr. Osborne has given concerts in the United States, Italy, France, Switzerland, Spain, and Greece, and has placed in several national and international competitions. In 2014, he and Jaime Carini played the US premiere of *The Apostles* by Naji Hakim.

With singer-songwriter Kim Harris, Mr. Osborne composed *Friends of Freedom* to introduce children to spirituals, opera and the underground railroad. In 2006, he was commissioned by the Festival Celebration Choir in Albany, NY to compose a piece, *Festival Te Deum*, which premiered in honor of their twentieth anniversary. In 2008, Mr. Osborne arranged pieces for papal liturgies during the visit of Pope Benedict XVI to New York City. The Basilica Choir of the Basilica of the National Shrine of Mary, Queen of the Universe in Orlando has recorded two of his compositions, *Salve Regina* and *God We Would Hear the Angels Sing*.
